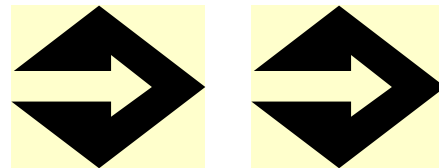
**IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR DENALI KIDCARE RENEWALS**

Beginning August 1, 2006, U.S. citizens renewing Denali KidCare benefits will need to provide proof of U.S. citizenship and identity. This is due to a change in federal law that took effect on July 1, 2006.

For most citizens, this means providing a birth certificate and some form of identification. This requirement does not affect immigrants applying for, or renewing Denali KidCare. These individuals who declare they are in satisfactory status are already required to show proof of their immigration status.

This information is only needed for the individuals who will receive benefits. Proof is not needed for individuals renewing Denali KidCare on behalf of someone else.
